RULES for the SUMMER BLUEBELL COMPETITION 2020.

COST to Players: The Player fee for this competition is \$ 20.00 per player which must be with the BSAACT bank account before a financial member can compete.

A. The competition:

1. The 2020 Summer Bluebell 6Red competition is a handicap competition.
2. Each match is 'best of 4' games.
3. Each game is a 'best of three' frames.
4. Each player may play a maximum of 2 games per match.
5. At the end of each **match**, players will adjust their handicap as follows:

Play 2 games and win 2; handicap goes down by 4,
Play 1 game and win 1; handicap goes down by 2,
Play 2 games and win 1 and lose 1; handicap stays the same,
Play 1 game and lose 1; handicap goes up by 2,
Play 2 games and lose 2; handicap goes up by 4.

Players will be responsible to keep a record of their results and changing handicap.

6. The scorecards are to be filled in as indicated in the Competition rules **with the exception that if there is no dispute, each team representative is to write only "AGREE" in the space required for signature.**
